

Kneeling


After the Holy, Holy and Holy and during the Eucharistic prayer until after the acclamation ("The Mystery of Faith") After receiving the Holy Communion.



throughout the year! Pray daily and listen for how God is calling each of us to joyfully use our gifts to fulfill His saluation plan.




